Feel free to come down on prep or to bring a whole class. We had a small audience last year, thanks to Mr. Hool's classes and Ms. Poloni's class!

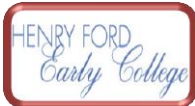


**Math League Contest: Feb. 17**
