Our next Relay for Life meeting will be held on Monday March 6th from 3:00-4:45 in Ms. Poloni's room C-8.



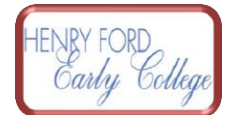
**Dearborn High at Stout: March 27, 2017**
