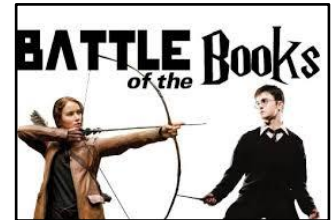


Reem thinks that, *"No matter how much you hate school, you will always miss it when you leave!"*
