The Student Council is having its next meeting on Tuesday, March 28th from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm in room G-3. Thanks – Ms. Schulkey

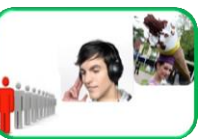


Boys Swim Team Beat Salina: 106-54
