

- 2. School behavior (bus, hallway, class, cafeteria, etc.) must be strong else you won't be permitted to join.
- 3. Students must have a Sports' Physical completed <u>before the first practice on 4/17</u>. If you've already played football, basketball, swimming, or volleyball for Stout, you already have a physical on file. If you haven't, get one from the office and let your doctor fill it out ASAP!
