
STC Takes a Magical Carpet Ride with Disney's Aladdin Jr.

Stout Track is Back!

Spring arrives along with the **2017 Stout Track Season** for 7th and 8th graders! <u>The first day of tryouts will take place on MONDAY, APRIL 17th!</u>

If you plan to tryout, please read the following requirements:

- 1. Students must have a **minimum of 2.0 on their marking period 4 report card** and maintain that GPA (or above) throughout the season. If a 2.0 is lost, the athlete will be dismissed from the team.
- 2. School behavior (bus, hallway, class, cafeteria, etc.) must be strong else you won't be permitted to join.
- 3. Students must have a Sports' Physical completed <u>before the first practice on 4/17</u>. If you've already played football, basketball, swimming, or volleyball for Stout, you already have a physical on file. <u>If you haven't, get one from the office and let your doctor fill it out ASAP!</u>

ATTENTION THEATER STUDENTS: If you are interested in being part of the track team, please see **Coach Hool (boys) or Coach Crechiolo (girls)** to make us aware of your interest, as the play performances don't end until after track season begins.
