Trying Out for Girls' Basketball Team

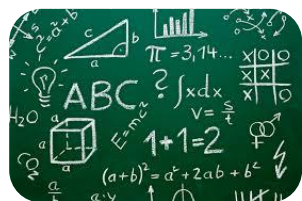
All 6th, 7th and 8th grade girls interested in trying out for girls' basketball team must:
