1. You must have a minimum of 2.0 on your marking period- 3 report card and maintain that GPA (or above) throughout the season. If a 2.0 is not reached or is lost, the athlete will be dismissed from the team.
2. School behavior (bus, hallway, class, cafeteria, etc.) must be strong. Students with poor behavior will not be permitted to join.
3. You must have a sports' physical completed *before* you can participate (before the first practice on 4/10). If you've already played football, basketball, swimming, or volleyball for Stout, you already have a physical on file. If you haven't played a sport yet, get a physical ASAP...they can be found in the office and must be filled out by a doctor!.
