On Wednesday, Oct. 10th, there will be a bake sale to support the PTA. Donations of baked goods are accepted in the office by 9am.






Varsity Volleyball Girls Back to their winning ways!

- Be courteous and speak to the driver and to each other using polite tone and proper volume.
- Not use bad or foul language.
- Not fight, push, or shove.

Failure to do so will result in consequences that include:

- detentions
- suspensions
- community work
- ban from school trips or activities
- kicking the violators off the bus for the remainder of the month
