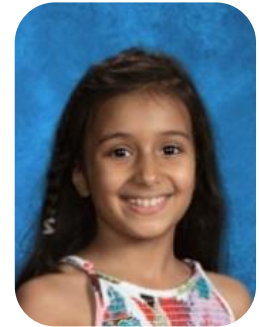
Mohamed Yahya, a 6th grader, had this revealing quote to share with us:

- Not eat or drink on the bus.
- Keep the bus tidy and clean.
- Not damage bus or equipment.
- Not throw any objects inside or outside the bus.

- ban from school trips or activities
- kicking the violators off the bus for the remainder of the month
