
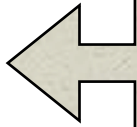

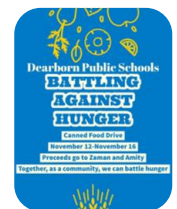


Parent-Teacher Conferences: Nov. 12 & Nov. 14
