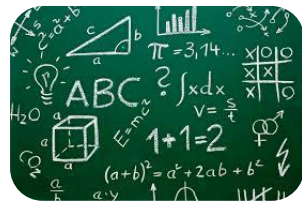
GeoBee is back: Friday, January 25, 2019
