Boys Swim Tryouts will be Monday, January 28 from 3:00 - 4:45pm.

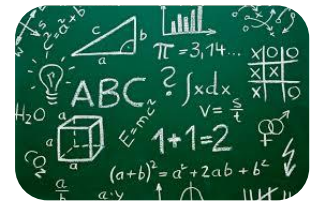
- You need to have physical with you or on file.
