**Pennies for Pasta to fight blood cancer: March 06 - 22**

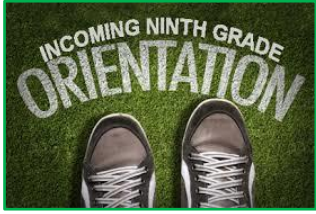
