There will be an Edsel Ford High School volleyball meeting for incoming freshmen on March 22nd at 7:00pm in the EFHS cafeteria.

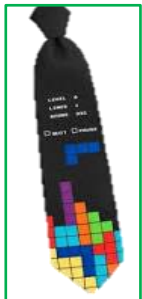


### **Battle of the Books: Return your final books**
