1. Students must have **a minimum of a 2.0 GPA and maintain that (or above) throughout the season.** If a 2.0 is not reached or is lost, the athlete will be dismissed from the team.
2. School behavior (bus, hallway, class, cafeteria, etc.) must be appropriate. **Students with poor behavior will not be permitted to join,** or can be removed if behavior becomes negative at any point during the season..
3. Students **must have a sports physical completed BEFORE they can participate in the first practice on April 8<sup>th</sup>.** If you've already played football, basketball, swimming, or volleyball for Stout, you already have a physical on file. **If you haven't played a sport yet, get a physical form from the office ASAP and let a doctor fill it out!**
