- Tuesday June 11, 2019: Yearbook sales \$15.00 before/after school/Lunch periods.

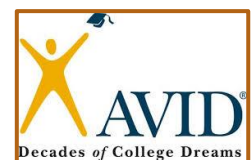


Attention any 8th grade hockey players:
