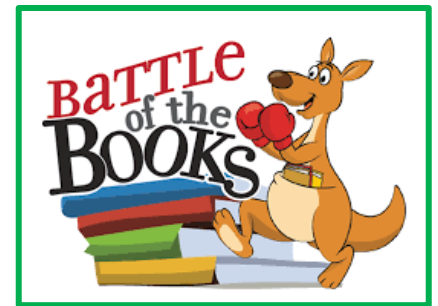
The Battle of Books is coming back to Stout
