Henry Ford Collegiate Academy

- Must obtain qualifying PSAT 10 scores
- Begins in 11th Grade
- Attend Home School DHS, EFHS, or FHS
- 5-year High School program
- Obtain an Associate's Degree and/or 60+ Transferable
 Credits
- Transportation is NOT provided

Henry Ford Collegiate Academy



- Attend home high school and Henry Ford College
- 11th grade Most classes at home high school plus 1-2 classes at Henry Ford College
- 12th grade 1 class at home high school and the rest at Henry Ford College
- Walk in high school graduation
- 13th year all college classes

HFEC and Henry Ford Collegiate Academy

- College coursework and books are provided.
- Upon graduation after the 13th year, students are eligible for Freshman scholarships at 4 year institutions they apply for.
- Provided a counselor for the early college or Collegiate
 Academy and college advisor

Honors Classes

Honors classes are offered at Edsel Ford and Fordson High School in Language Arts (9th and 10th grades), Geometry (9th grade), Algebra 2 (10th grade), Pre-Calculus (11th grade), Biology (9th grade), Chemistry (10th and 11th grades) and Physics (10th and 11th grades).

- faster paced and more rigorous than non-honors classes
- Enrollment is limited and is based on past grades, test scores, and teacher recommendation.

Dearborn High School is piloting a program that provides all students access to honors level material. Students who demonstrate "honors level" performance throughout the semester in assessments, projects, and performance tasks receive the honors designation.

Advanced Placement Courses

Advanced placement classes offer high school students universitylevel courses at their high schools or online through the Michigan Virtual High School.

Enrollment is open to all students in the 11th and 12th grades.

Students must take the AP test and achieve a passing score to be awarded college credit by the college or university they attend after high school.
