Dear Residents of Ternes from Colson Ave. to East Hubbard Dr.

As we informed you during the public meeting on **February 7, 2019**, the City of Dearborn has scheduled a Federally-mandated sewer separation project in your neighborhood. This is a continuation of the sewer separation project completed last year on Firestone, Walwit and Normandale.

Pamar Enterprises, Inc., the contractor for this current project, will begin working in your street constructing storm sewers and or water mains during the week of June 17, 2019 on **Ternes from South of Hubbard Dr. East to Colson Ave.**

All underground construction on your street will take approximately eight (8) weeks to complete. Access to driveways and garages will be maintained during the project except approximately six (6) hours during excavation and construction of the storm sewer in front of your driveway.

Following the storm sewer and water main construction, the contractor will pave your street with new eight inch (8") thick concrete pavement full width, curb to curb. Parking on your street will be restricted during paving operations but you will be notified in advance of this stage of work. Grass between the curb and sidewalk will be restored with topsoil and sod. Driveway aprons between the curb and sidewalk will be restored with new five inch (5) thick concrete.

All storm sewer and concrete paving work on your street is anticipated to be completed within fourteen (14) to sixteen (16) weeks.

Trash, Recycle Carts and Yard Waste Collection – Sanitation will be picked up by the Sanitation Contractor between 6:30 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. We encourage property owners to clearly label their carts with property address and to drop off their trash, recycle carts and yard waste at the curb side prior to 6:00 a.m. the day of collection or overnight. City contractors may need to transport your carts to the nearest intersection. Once the carts have been emptied, the contractor will return them to the front of your house.

It is planned to keep inconvenience to affected property owners to a minimum while we execute this important project. Your cooperation is requested so that we may be able to serve you better.
