As part of our ongoing effort to keep an open line of communication, I would like to take a moment to share information with you regarding a reported stanger incident.

It was brought to our attention that one of our students was approached by a man asking him if he wanted a ride to school. The student told the man I know how to get to school. Another student approached and then the man reverted back to his car. The students then walked to school. The incident was reported to the police.

As parents, you can also help to keep our community safe. Please take a moment to discuss with your child how to be safe to and from school and when they are out playing in the neighborhood. Here are a few helpful reminders:

- Never talk to a stranger.
- Never get into a car with a stranger, even if they tell you they are looking for a lost pet or someone you know is hurt and they will take you to them.
- Children should walk to and from school with other children.
- Always report suspicious characters to parents, teachers and the police.
- If approached by a stranger, tell an adult.

We live in a safe community but in order for us to keep our community safe, we must be good neighbors, keep an open line of communication, and work together so our children can be safe at home, in the neighborhood, or walking to and from school.
