MISTAR-Q Grade Book & Google Classroom

Classes are created in Google Classroom by MISTAR-Q and students are automatically enrolled in them

Teachers create and score assignments in Google Classroom

Assignments & scores may be automatically imported

OR

Teachers may manually import assignments & scores



Google Classroom Setup





Accept Classes


In Google Classroom, classes initially appear as invitations

Click the ACCEPT button

Students cannot view the class until it is accepted

After clicking accept, confirm by clicking ACCEPT again to reveal the class to students and access the class







Decline Classes

If you click Decline, the invitation will be withdrawn and the class will be removed from your Google Classroom

Click Cancel if this was a mistake

Grade Categories in Google Classroom MUST be created **exactly** as they are in MISTAR-Q Grade Book for the import process to work







Several Grade Book preferences affect the Google integration


Use the Preference cog in the bottom left corner of the Grade Book screen and set each preference to YES or NO





Auto-Calculate Standard Marks

YES: assignments associated with standards in MISTAR-Q Grade Book will have their standard marks automatically calculated when the score is imported






Automatically Import Google Assignments and Scores Nightly

YES: assignments and scores will be imported from Google each night

NO: teacher will manually import assignments and scores

Teachers using Standard Marks must set to NO See Working with Standards






Automatically Remove Withdrawn Students from Google Classes

YES: withdrawn students will be automatically removed from Google Classes

NO: teacher will manually remove students when ready (recommended)

Setting to YES can have serious consequences as Google will delete everything for student when student is withdrawn







Set Is Graded ON when Scores are Imported for an Assignment

YES: assignment will be marked as graded when scores are imported

NO: teachers will manually mark the assignment as graded



In Setup: Courses Tab

Lists Google Classes - the Course State is important

Provisioned – Needs to be accepted in Google Classroom

Active – After accepting shows Linked Grade Book Section – **only Active classes can interface with Grade Book**

Declined – If declined by mistake, check **Provision** to re-enable in Google Classroom

Archived – Class was archived in Google Classroom and removed from class list

In Setup: Course Work Tab

Shows Course Work for the class selected in the banner

When assignments are imported into MISTAR-Q, they will automatically be created in the Grade Book and linked to the Google Classwork item

The Linked Gradebook Assignment column will display the assignment

Each item listed must be linked to a Grade Book assignment before scores can be imported

In Setup: Topics Setup & Sync Topics

Topics are an optional way to set-up classes when one class is the primary and each additional class has the **same roster of students**

A common example is an elementary grade level class with core subject sections (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies) set as topics under that class

Preparing to Import - Setup Steps

- √ Grade Book is completely set-up
- ✓ All Google Classes show as Active in Grade Book on the Google Sync > Courses Tab and are linked to the correct section
- ✓ Grade Categories in Google Classroom for each class are set and exactly match Grade Book categories for the linked section
- ✓ Preferences have been reviewed and adjusted



Preparing to Import - Assignments in Google

Assign a Category in Google Classroom that matches a MISTAR-Q Grade Book Category for this class

Enter a due date for the assignment that falls within the MISTAR-Q term dates

Set a point value for the assignment

Create assignment titles that make it easy to identify in MISTAR-Q Grade Book


Return scores to student(s)



Google Import - Two Options

Schools may establish an automatic nightly sync of assignments/scores from Google Classroom to MISTAR Grade Book

Scores will be imported nightly whenever the assignment has been graded in Google Classroom and scores are **returned** to the student



OR

Teachers may disable the nightly automatic sync in Grade Book preferences and, instead, manually import assignments & scores from the Google Import tab in Grade Book




Google Import - Manual Import

To manually import, click the **Google Import** tab in MISTAR Grade Book

Select the sections to import from the list at right

Select what to import: Assignments, Scores, or both Assignments & Scores

Scores must be **returned** in Google Classroom before they will import






Google Import - Manual Import

Click Process and a processing screen will appear

Click Close when complete







Google Import

Rejected transactions will display in red








Google Import

After importing assignments and scores, check the results in the Grade Book

The **Assignment Graded** indicator may need to be changed if the preference

to automatically turn it on is set to No





Google Import - Standards

If the scoring standards rather than traditional points-based marks:

In the Google Import tab, import assignments only (not scores)

Edit the assignments to link standards

Return to the Google Import tab and import scores only

Once standards are linked to assignments, they may be imported together with scores if there are updates
